

WHAT DOES \$10 MILLION MEAN TO MY SCHOOL?

The Governor's proposed 2009-2010 state budget would cut approximately \$6 billion of California's funding for schools. A cut of this size would require the Pasadena Unified School District to cut approximately \$5 million from its budget. Take a look at the numbers below to determine what this cut may look like at your child's school:
