

Parcel Tax Resolution



- Amount: \$120 per year on each parcel of taxable real property within the District's boundaries
- Currently approximately 59,700 taxable parcels – would generate \$7,164,000 annually
- Length : 5 years

Parcel Tax Resolution



- Date of Election: May 4, 2010 – Mail ballot only election – All registered voters within the District’s boundaries will receive a ballot in the mail in early April, with a deadline of May 4
- Included - a senior citizen needs based exemption
- Included - a provision for an “Independent Community Oversight Committee”.

Ballot Statement

“To provide educational opportunities so local students are prepared to succeed in college and careers; to retain quality teachers; continue funding academic programs in advanced math, science, technology, music and art; keep school libraries open, and lessen the impact of state budget cuts, shall Pasadena Unified School District levy a tax of \$120 per parcel annually for five years, with independent citizens’ oversight, exemptions for low-income seniors, and with all funds benefiting our local schools and students?”
